

Roller Blinds

Fabric Rolling Direction

Back Roll

Fabric will roll off of the back of the tube towards the glass of the window. This option will provide better light blocking as the fabric hangs closer to the window, glass, architrave or wall.

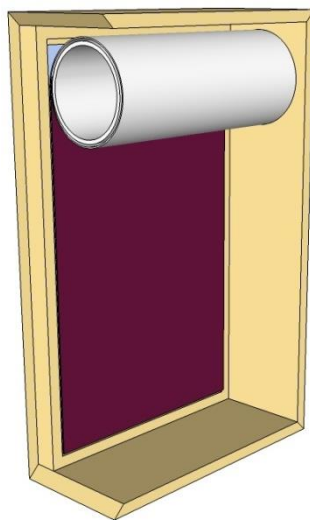
The roll at the top of the blind will be visible with this option so please be aware that some fabrics have a different colour backing (e.g. white backed blackout fabrics), and that this can be very noticeable. The customer should be aware of this when ordering and if this different colour is not suitable, a pelmet should be used to cover the roll, or the front roll option should be chosen.

Front Roll

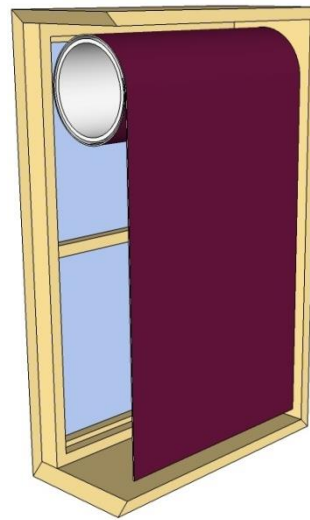
Fabric will roll off of the front of the tube towards the room. This option will allow more light penetration around the sides of the blind (particularly in outside mount applications) as the fabric sits further away from the window glass.

The roll at the top of the blind will not be visible with this option, so may be the preferred choice for fabrics with a different backing colour (e.g. white-backed fabrics.)

Note: To achieve a maximum light block, use the back roll combined with outside mount.

Fabric Attachment Method

The fabric is attached to the tube with a heavy duty double sided tape. The fabric is then looped fully around the tube to lock the fabric into place. This ensures there will not be any tube visible, even when the blind is fully down.
